

U.S. Laws and Policies Restricting or Prohibiting Smoking in Private Units of Multi-Unit Housing

October 3, 2017

This list contains several tables that represent communities with municipal laws or Housing Authority policies that restrict or prohibit smoking to various degrees in **private units** of specified types of multi-unit housing.

Additionally, communities that are not on this list may have municipal laws or Housing Authority policies that do not address smoking in private units, but otherwise restrict smoking in multi-unit housing, such as by prohibiting smoking in indoor common areas or on patios and balconies.

Note: The jurisdiction(s) affected by county-level laws vary widely. Look for a ^ symbol next to each county with a law that includes both incorporated and unincorporated areas. A county without a symbol means that the county law covers unincorporated areas only.

Municipalities with Laws Addressing Multi-Unit Housing

Municipalities with Laws for 100% Smokefree Multi-Unit Housing:

This table represents communities that have enacted **municipal laws** at the city or county level that prohibit smoking in **100% of private units** of all specified types of multi-unit housing. These laws typically apply to both privately-owned and publicly-owned multi-unit buildings. These laws apply to all existing and future buildings, and do not permit current residents to continue smoking in the building (i.e. no “grandfathering” clause).

Municipalities with Laws that Restrict Smoking in Multi-Unit Housing:

This table represents communities that have **municipal laws** at the city or county level that do not prohibit smoking in *all* units of *all* multi-unit residential buildings in the community, but restrict smoking in **private units** of some specified types of multi-unit buildings. These laws typically apply to both privately-owned and publicly-owned multi-unit housing. Laws marked with # will require all multi-unit buildings to be 100% smokefree as of a future date.

Municipalities marked **Some** under “All Units Currently Smokefree?” have some buildings that are currently required to be 100% smokefree. Often, these laws prohibit smoking in all newly occupied buildings or newly leased units, but either do not address smoking in existing buildings or only apply to a certain percent of units in existing buildings. Municipalities marked with # means that the law will eventually require all multi-unit buildings to be 100% smokefree as of a future date, but currently the law provides partial coverage.

Municipalities marked **No** under “All Units Currently Smokefree?” have no buildings required to be 100% smokefree now or in the future. These laws may apply to only a certain percent of units in existing and future buildings, or permit current residents to continue smoking in the building (“grandfathering” clause).

Publicly-Owned Multi-Unit Housing

This table lists communities that have smokefree policies for Publicly-Owned Multi-Unit Housing, the majority of which are adopted by a Public Housing Authority to restrict or prohibit smoking in private units of the buildings it owns and manages. Public Housing Authority policies cover all or specified buildings that are owned and managed by the Housing Authority, but these policies do not regulate smoking in other types of subsidized housing in the community that are privately-owned. The table also lists some communities that have adopted smokefree laws/resolutions that cover other types of affordable housing owned by the municipality.

State Laws and Policies Prohibiting Smoking in Private Units of Multi-Unit Housing

Delaware: The Delaware State Housing Authority prohibits smoking in all units of all buildings it owns and manages as of 10/1/2013.

Hawaii: Hawaii prohibits smoking in all units of all buildings under the jurisdiction of the Hawaii Public Housing Authority as of 6/16/2014. The Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation requires that all new and sold/renovated properties that receive tax credits through their program have a smokefree policy as of 2015.

Maine: MaineHousing, the State Housing Authority, requires that smoking be prohibited in all units of all buildings built and financed by the state's Low Income Housing Tax Credit program as of 2013.

Montana: The Montana Board of Housing requires buildings that receive tax credits through their program have a smokefree policy as of 2016.

New Hampshire: The New Hampshire Housing Finance Authority requires buildings that receive tax credits through their program have a smokefree policy as of 2017.

North Carolina: The North Carolina Housing Finance Agency requires buildings that receive tax credits through their program have a smokefree policy as of 2015.

Washington: The Washington State Housing Trust Fund requires that affordable housing projects receiving funding must adhere to the Evergreen Sustainable Development Standard, which requires all properties to have a smokefree policy as of 2016.

Definitions and Explanatory Notes:

Municipal Laws:

► Communities on the two charts of municipal laws adopted a municipal ordinance to regulate smoking in all (first chart) or some (second chart) types of multi-unit housing. The two charts break out information by coverage for privately-owned and publicly-owned multi-unit housing.

^ = Law applies only to unincorporated areas of the county.

= Law will require all multi-unit buildings to be 100% smokefree as of a future date, but currently the law provides partial coverage.

All Units Currently Smokefree?:

Yes: 100% of units of all specified types of multi-unit buildings are required to be smokefree. Includes existing and future buildings.

Some: 100% of units in some specified types of multi-unit buildings are required to be smokefree. Often, these laws prohibit smoking in all newly occupied buildings or newly leased units, but either do not address smoking in existing buildings or only apply to a certain percent of units in existing buildings.

No: No buildings are required to be 100% be smokefree now or in the future. These laws may prohibit smoking in only a certain percent of units in existing and future buildings, or permit current residents to continue smoking in the building (“grandfathering” clause).

Minimum Percent of Units Currently Smokefree:

The percent of specified multi-unit housing that is currently required to be smokefree:

100%: All units in specified multi-unit housing must be smokefree.

Another stated %: The stated percent of units in specified multi-unit housing must be smokefree.

N/S = Not Specified: The law does not specify the percent of units currently required to be smokefree or the percent of units currently required to be smokefree cannot be determined by how the law is written, such as: applying only to new multi-unit buildings but not to existing multi-unit buildings or designating at certain percentage of units as nonsmoking or limiting smoking to certain buildings or permitting current residents to continue to smoke indefinitely.

Initial Effective Date:

The date when some multi-unit housing must be 100% smokefree. For example, Baldwin Park, CA (marked as Some for All Units Currently Smokefree) requires that all newly occupied buildings must be 100% smokefree as of 6/21/2012, which is the Initial Effective Date. Baldwin Park also requires that at least 80% of units in all existing buildings be smokefree. Because existing buildings may never be fully smokefree, the Final Effective Date is “Not Specified.”

Not Specified: The law does not specify when all multi-unit buildings must be completely smokefree, due to provisions such as: law permits current residents to continue smoking indefinitely **or** law applies only to newly constructed buildings **or** law applies only to a certain percent of existing units.

Final Effective Date:

For communities marked as Yes or Some for All Units Currently Smokefree, the Final Effective Date is when all buildings must be 100% smokefree. For communities marked as No for All Units Currently Smokefree, the Final Effective Date is when the strongest provisions of the law goes into effect.

Not Specified: The law does not specify when all multi-unit buildings must be completely smokefree, due to provisions such as: law permits current residents to continue smoking indefinitely **or** law applies only to newly constructed buildings **or** law applies only to a certain percent of existing units.

Patios/Balconies:

Yes: The smoking restrictions also apply to outdoor private use areas such as balconies and patios that are connected to individual units.

Condos:

Yes: Condominiums and other owner-occupied multi-unit housing are included in the law.

Publicly-Owned Housing:

Publicly-owned housing refers to properties that are owned or operated by a local or state government agency, typically called a Public Housing Authority or Agency. Communities typically have other types of affordable housing, which are privately-owned properties that receive financial subsidies to provide housing to low-income residents. Public Housing Authorities typically do not have authority to determine policy for these other types of affordable properties.

► Communities on this list represent policies adopted by a local Public Housing Authority for the buildings it owns or operates.

All Units Currently Smokefree?:

Yes: 100% of units of all specified types of publicly-owned multi-unit buildings are required to be smokefree. Includes existing and future buildings.

Some: 100% of units in some specified types of publicly-owned multi-unit buildings are required to be smokefree. Often, these laws prohibit smoking in all newly occupied buildings or newly leased units, but either do not address smoking in existing buildings or only apply to a certain percent of units in existing buildings.

No: No buildings are required to be 100% be smokefree now or in the future. These laws may prohibit smoking in only a certain percent of units in existing and future buildings, or permit current residents to continue smoking in the building (“grandfathering” clause).

Minimum Percent of Units Currently Smokefree:

The percent of specified publicly-owned housing that is currently required to be smokefree:

100%: All units in specified publicly-owned housing must be smokefree.

Another stated %: The stated percent of units in specified publicly-owned housing must be smokefree.

N/S = Not Specified: The law does not specify the percent of units currently required to be smokefree *or* the percent of units currently required to be smokefree cannot be determined by how the law is written, such as: applying only to new multi-unit buildings but not to existing multi-unit buildings *or* designating a certain percentage of units as nonsmoking *or* limiting smoking to certain buildings *or* permitting current residents to continue to smoke indefinitely.

Final Effective Date:

For communities marked as Yes or Some for All Units Currently Smokefree, the Final Effective Date is when all specified buildings must be 100% smokefree. For communities marked as No for All Units Currently Smokefree, the Final Effective Date is when the strongest provisions of the law go into effect.

Not Specified: The law does not specify when all multi-unit buildings must be completely smokefree, due to provisions such as: law permits current residents to continue smoking indefinitely *or* law applies only to newly constructed buildings *or* law applies only to a certain percent of existing units.

Patios/Balconies:

Yes: The smoking restrictions also apply to outdoor private use areas such as balconies and patios that are connected to individual units.
